

## About Messengers of Messiah and Peter A. Michas

Peter A. Michas is the founder, senior pastor and teacher of Messengers of Messiah. His unique teaching ministry combines in-depth knowledge of the Word of God, study of the Hebrew and Greek languages, plus understanding of the Hebraic culture and history.

Almost thirty years ago, Peter A. Michas was led by the Spirit of God to study the Word of God from what is now referred to as the Hebraic Roots perspective. While studying the Greek text of the New Testament, Peter realized that the Greek language – a logical, analytical language – was written in such a way as to express ideas in pictures and that this must have something to do with the Hebrew language and the way Hebraic thoughts and ideas are expressed. Knowing that Jews (and Israelites) wrote the Bible about the Jew, Messiah Yeshua (Christ Jesus), Peter realized he needed to study Jewish/Hebraic works and commentaries for greater understanding of the Hebrew Bible (Old Testament), which is the essential foundation of the New Testament.

The Hebraic Roots perspective puts the Word of God back into its original context. This means that understanding the culture, language, customs, Biblical Holy Days, history, etc. is essential to understanding the true meaning and depth of the Word of God. Restoring the Hebraic Roots of the Word of God brings forth a much deeper, more meaningful, and powerful insight and understanding of God's Living Word.

Furthermore, to understand Christian beliefs, doctrines, practices, etc. today, it is essential to understand the history of Christianity, from the first-century church in its original form and how it was changed and developed over time, especially under the influence of paganism and Roman-Greek philosophic thought. Long ago, Christianity was robbed of its true Hebraic Roots and pagan holidays, customs, beliefs, practices, etc. were substituted in place of the true roots of the Biblical faith.

Peter's Greek heritage provides him with a unique understanding of Mediterranean culture and history, as well as the Greek language. He graduated from Bethesda Bible College in San Diego, California and began a 501(c)3 not-for-profit nondenominational ministry in 1980. Peter has also worked with the Israel Foreign Ministry office to promote a better understanding between Christian and Jewish communities. He has hosted a radio program and also been a guest on various radio and TV broadcasts. Peter has hosted many Israel tours with a highly educational and exciting perspective of the Land of Israel, including its history, archaeology, and Biblical connection.
