

Book of Hebrews Study (2009) Selected Teachings on the Deity of Messiah Yeshua (Christ Jesus)

HEB-01 (6/14/09) Book of Hebrews #1 The Deity of Messiah Yeshua

The Son, Yeshua, not a created being but equal with the Father. The “substance” or “basic nature” of God the Son identical with that of God the Father. Yeshua is The Light of God; God is Light. The Son is exactly the same as the Father but it is the Son Who interacts directly with Creation and Humanity, mediating between Father and Creation. Mary, not the mother of God (Theotokos), but the mother of the physical body of Yeshua.

HEB-02 (6/28/09) Book of Hebrews #2 The Work of Messiah Yeshua: God, Creator, and Redeemer

Messiah Yeshua, the Creator, and His work in creation and salvation. It was the will of God the Father that everything that exists was created by Yeshua. The Father’s plan of salvation was fulfilled in Yeshua. All creation belongs to Yeshua, Who will one day share it with those that belong to Him.

HEB-03 (7/5/09) The Book of Hebrews #3 The Son of God, the Exact Likeness of God the Father, the Source

Yeshua is the Light to the World, and is the visible and express image of the source, Father God. We humans cannot see Father God nor can we fully grasp His nature. Yeshua makes who and what the Father is visible and knowable to humans.

HEB-04 (7/12/09) The Book of Hebrews #4 “Sustaining All Things by His Powerful Word” (Hebrews 1:3)

Messiah Yeshua is one with, and completely equal to, God the Father. The mind of God, the Word of God, and Creation through the Son of God. Without Yeshua, The Son, we humans would not exist or be able to live in Creation. All Creation is held together in a perfect balance by Yeshua Who is the ONLY mediator between man and God, between all Creation and God the Father.

HEB-18 (10/4/09) The Book of Hebrews #18 The Eternal Priesthood of Melchi-Tzedek from Shem to Yeshua

The deity of Yeshua must be understood to comprehend the nature of the eternal priesthood of Melchi-Tzedek and its fulfillment in Yeshua. The origin of this eternal priesthood was initiated by YHVH/Yeshua before creation, then passed to Shem/Melchi-Tzedek. Shem blesses Abraham, who would be the father of the Israelites from whom the Aaronic priesthood would come into being. This priesthood would come to an end at the Last Supper, with Yeshua creating the last earthly priesthood. The final priesthood would then be with Yeshua taking His place as the ultimate and eternal High Priest and King of Jerusalem.

HEB-20 (10/18/09) The Book of Hebrews #20 The Establishment of the New Covenant by Yeshua

Hebrews 8:6 to 9:12 covers the establishment of the New Covenant by Yeshua. Hebrews 9:1-12 covers a comparison between the Old and New Covenants and uses the Tabernacle in the Wilderness to show the difference between the earthly covenant and the heavenly covenant.
